Victoria was fortunate to marry her soulmate Eugene in 1946 and they soon began a family. She was blessed with 3 children: Gary (Shelley), Richard (Sherry) and Maria (Bruce). Victoria's door was always open for a visit, the coffee always on. She was an enthusiastic Roughrider fan, and her cheers could be heard halfway down the block on game day. Victoria adored her

grandchildren: Kate (Paul), Ryan (Melanie), Ash (Alexandra), Tyson (Lanae), Lisa (Alvin) and Brandon; and great-grandchildren: Addison, Isla, Preston, Ava, Ethan, Jacob and Maxwell.
