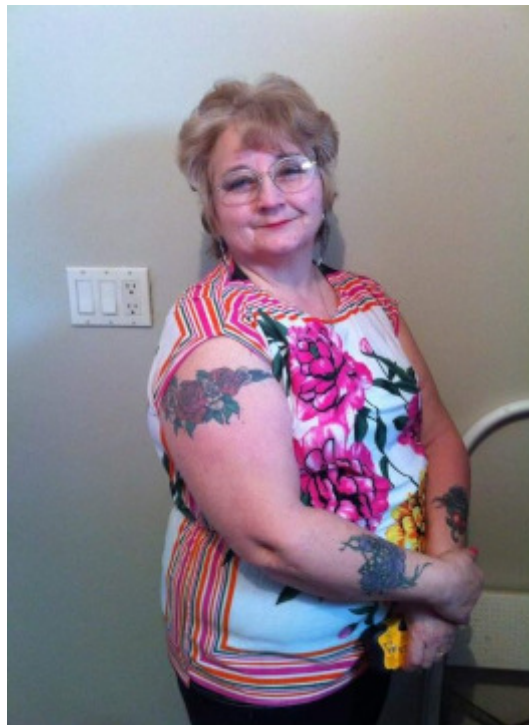
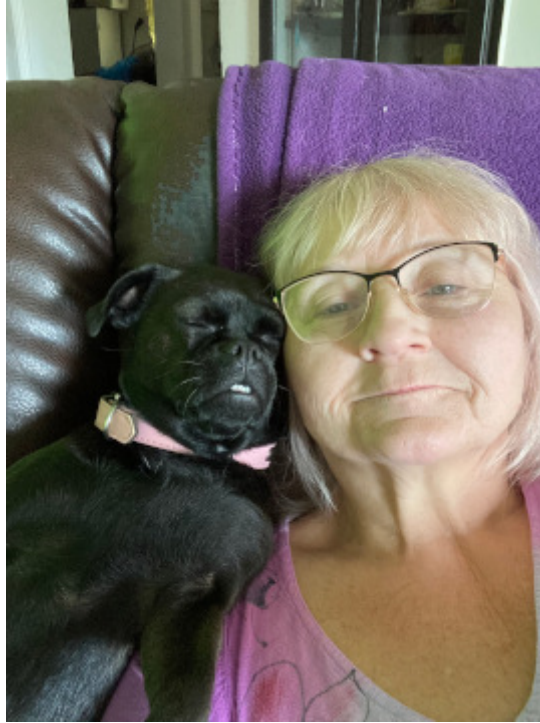


# Pulvermacher, Sherry Joan
