In the early 1990's Clarence put his skills and machinery to work building the Crescent View Par 3 Golf Course in Moose Jaw, SK. He was co-owner of the course and maintained the grounds until selling it in 2025.

Having lived his entire life in Spring Valley, Clarence always supported the community in any way he could, from volunteering and providing supplies for various suppers and events, buying local 4H animals, and keeping the town looking beautiful. He was always ready and willing to give someone a hand seeding, harvesting, fixing machinery, or whatever needed to be done.

Clarence enjoyed travelling and went many places, including Australia, New Zealand, Africa, Mexico, Belize, and throughout Canada and the USA. Fishing trips to northern Saskatchewan with family and friends were some of his favourite memories.
