Her favorite past times were playing cards and watching sports, especially curling. Mom was very active and independent up until the last few weeks of her life. She was predeceased by her husband, Gerald in 2008; and is survived by her son, Don (Sharon) and their children Jason and Chris, all of Saskatoon; and her daughter, Barb (Bob) Clarke of Moose Jaw

and their children Stacey (Matthew) McGeary of Saskatoon and Jeff of Grande Prairie.
