## FORREST ROBERT SCHULTZ (BOB) March 1st, 1928 – July 14th, 2015

Forrest Robert “Bob” Schultz, aged 87 years of Moose Jaw, SK, passed away Tuesday, July 14th, 2015 with his loving family by his side. Bob was born in Moose Jaw, SK and spent all of his life here. He grew up in Moose Jaw and worked at Johnstone Dairies. Following that, he was employed by the C.P.R. as a fireman and engineer. He went to work at Moose Jaw Hardware and then Ashdowns.
