She came to Canada in 1958, arriving a year after her husband and settled in Moose Jaw to make a life for themselves. She gave birth to 2 more children, Roger and Angie, to complete her family legacy. Liese was a stay at home Mom for most of her early years with us. She did work at the Co-op Cafeteria and as a cleaner at City Hall. She loved to dance, polka music, and sing. She also loved bright colours and flowers. She was a member of the German Canadian Club for many years and made friendships that lasted the rest of her life. Liese had a huge garden, canned her beet pickles and pickled her jack fish for many years, and

Our mother had an outgoing personality which made her lifelong friends that cherished every moment they spent together.

She was predeceased by her husband, Edmund in 2009. Liese's legacy continues on through her children: **Heide** (Jim), **Roger** (Connie), and **Angie** (Darrell); and grandchildren: Rob, Lisa, Alex, Nicole and Dakota.

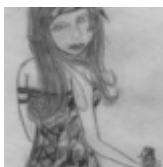
