A second son, Dwayne George was born November 5, 1955. In October of 1956, Pete starting working for Canada Packers Inc. where he worked until retirement in 1990. On August 18, 1958, their daughter Joanne Katherine was born. On February 11, 1986 his wife Bernice lost her courageous 5 year battle with illness and was laid to rest in Moose Jaw, SK.
