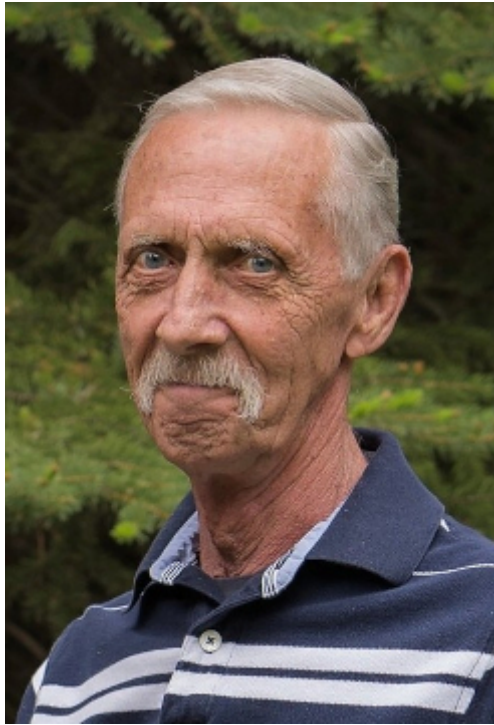


Smith, Peter Allan
