Robert “Bob” Alexander Smith, aged 71 years of Moose Jaw, SK passed away on Saturday, September 28th, 2019. Bob was born on April 9th, 1948 in Moose Jaw, SK to parents, Alexander and Kathleen Smith. He attended Alexander School and Peacock Collegiate in Moose Jaw before joining the Royal Canadian Navy, becoming an Aero Engine Technician and moving to Shearwater, Nova Scotia from 1965 – 1967. In 1967, Bob returned to Moose Jaw to work as an orderly at the Providence Hospital. In 1990, he became Purchasing Agent of Materials Management at the hospital, moving later to Providence Place.
