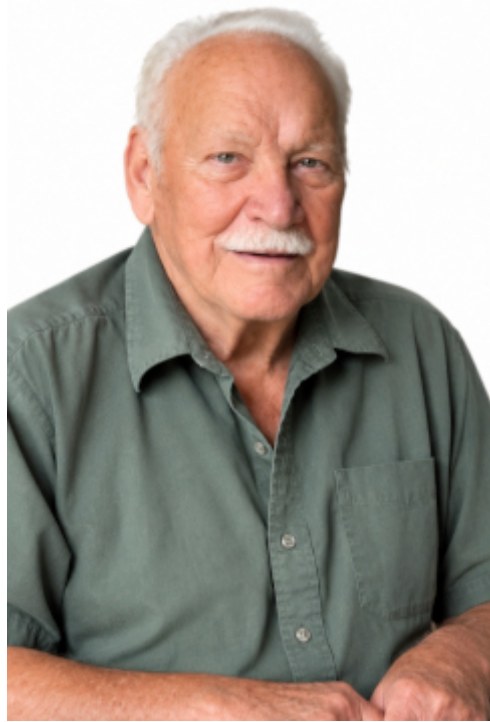


Spearing, Kenneth Garfield
