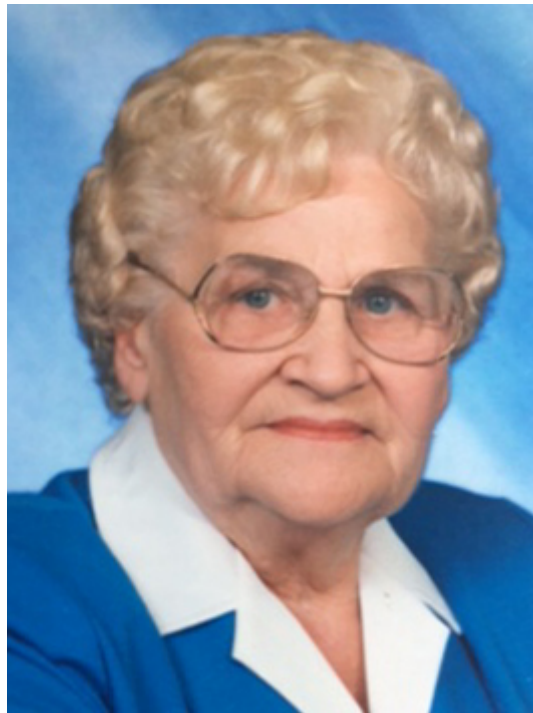


Sydia, Sophie
