It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of our father and hero, Tom Taylor on Saturday, December 19th, 2015. At the age of 19, he moved to Moose Jaw where he attended Normal School to become a teacher. He began his 35 year teaching career in a one room school house in Lake Alma, SK, where he met the love of his life, Joyce Torgunrud. They were married on July 6th, 1950 and were blessed with three daughters. His job eventually brought him to Moose Jaw where he taught at Bushell Park, Ross and Empire Schools until his retirement in 1982. Tom was admired and respected by his colleagues and students. Always young at heart, his greatest joy in life was his family, with whom he spent numerous hours. Dad could always be found playing with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren. He was an avid supporter and season ticket holder of the Moose Jaw Canucks and Warrior hockey teams, taking many of his grandchildren to the games with him. spent many hours volunteering with local charities and organizations. Dad worked tirelessly in his yard where his flowers bloomed with great love, his lawn was kept flawlessly manicured and his hedge perfectly squared. We will love and miss him forever. He was predeceased by his wife, Joyce; his parents; two older brothers; son-in-law, Dan; and grandson-in-law, Ryan.
