It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Carol Ann Watson, who passed away peacefully at Pioneer Lodge in Palliative Care on Thursday, July 11th, 2024, in Moose Jaw, SK.

Carol was born on September 1st, 1954, in Moose Jaw, SK. She worked in the laundry department at St. Anthony's from 1973 until its closure, and moved to laundry at Providence Place until 2007, then transferred to Pioneer Lodge to work in housekeeping until 2009, at which point she retired as she could no longer work due to a brain aneurism.

Carol was a loving wife, mother, sister, auntie, and grandmother. She married the love of her life, Darrell, on May 17th, 1975, and was married for 49 wonderful years. They were blessed with 3 children: Nicole, Anita, and Jason. Carol
