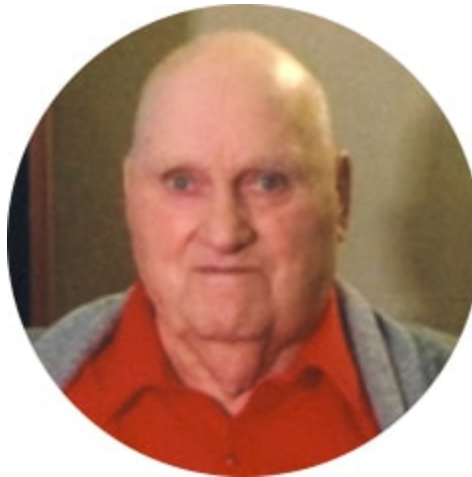


Wells, Robert Glyn

Robert Glyn Wells, aged 83 years of Moose Jaw, SK, passed away on Saturday, November 2nd, 2013 at the Moose Jaw Union Hospital after a long, courageous battle with end stage kidney disease and pneumonia.
