John Clarence Wilson, aged 80 years of Moose Jaw, SK, passed away on Monday, February 8th, 2016. John was born on August 17th, 1935 and was the second son of Elizabeth and Chester Wilson. He received his education at Summerside School in Archydal, Moose Jaw Tech and Moose Jaw Teachers College, as well as at the University of Regina where he received his B.Ed.
